AN ACT

RELATING TO INTIMIDATION WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON, AND MAKING
PENALTIES APPLICABLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:


Section 1. Section 708.6, Code 2026, is amended to read as follows:

708.6 Intimidation with a dangerous weapon.


1. A person commits a class "C" felony when the person, with the intent to injure or provoke fear or anger ~~in another,~~ shoots, throws, launches, or discharges a dangerous weapon at another person or at, into, or in a building, vehicle, airplane, railroad engine, railroad car, or boat, occupied by another person, ~~or within an assembly of people, and thereby places the occupants or people in reasonable apprehension of serious injury~~ or threatens to commit such an act under circumstances raising a reasonable expectation that the threat will be carried out.

2. A person commits a class "D" felony when the person shoots, throws, launches, or discharges a dangerous weapon at another person or at, into, or in a building, vehicle, airplane, railroad engine, railroad car, or boat, occupied by another person, ~~or within an assembly of people, and thereby places the occupants or people in reasonable apprehension of~~

~~serious injury~~ or threatens to commit such an act under circumstances raising a reasonable expectation that the threat will be carried out.


