AN ACT
RELATING TO THE DISPLAY OF FLAGS AT HALF-STAFF ON PUBLIC
BUILDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 1B.3, Code 2026, is amended to read as follows:

1B.3 Flags on public buildings.


1. As used in this section, "public building" means a vertical improvement, as defined in section 15J.2, used for a public purpose by the state or a political subdivision of the state.

2. ~~It shall be the duty of any~~ A board of public officers charged with providing supplies for a public building in the state ~~to~~ shall provide a suitable state flag, and ~~it shall be the duty of~~ the custodian of that public building ~~to~~ shall raise the flags of the United States of America and the state of Iowa, upon each secular day when weather conditions are favorable.

3. The custodian and the board of public officers of a public building in the state shall have the flags of the United States of America and the state of Iowa flown at half-staff when so directed by a proclamation issued by the governor.

4. A person may report an alleged violation of subsection 3 to the attorney general. The attorney general may initiate an action in the name of the state, including but not limited

to an action for injunctive relief, to obtain compliance with subsection 3.


