A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the filing and recording of plats for
the laying out or subdividing of tracts of land
within cities having a city plan commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section four hundred nine point fourteen
- 2 (409.14), Code 1958, is amended by inserting immediately
- 3 following the word "over," in line seven (7) the following:
- 4 "or within a city of any size having a plan commission
- 5 organized under the provisions of chapter three hundred
- 6 seventy-three (373) of the Code".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 109

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the above section by making it definite that cities mentioned herein may control the orderly development of adjacent territory. Under the present law, section 409.14 applies only to cities over 25,000 population. Many smaller cities are creating plan commissions for future orderly development and expansion.
