A BILL FOR

An Act relating to amounts of indemnification of drivers of emergency vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point four
2 hundred ninety-six (821.496), Code 1958, is hereby amended as
3 follows:

4 1. By striking from line five (5) the word "one" and in-
5 serting in lieu thereof the word "ten".

6 2. By striking from line six (6) the word "five" and in-
7 serting in lieu thereof the word "fifty".

8 3. By striking from line seven (7) the word "ten" and in-
9 serting in lieu thereof the word "one hundred".

10 4. By striking all of lines fifteen (15) through twenty
11 (20), inclusive, and the word "person" in line twenty-one
12 (21), and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "in excess
13 of the foregoing amounts."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 134

The present amounts of coverage are not adequate protection for drivers of fire and police department emergency vehicles against whom suits may be brought for damages resulting from their operation of motor vehicles while in the performance of their duties.
