## A BILL FOR

An Act requiring death notices to be sent to the county auditor.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-four point ten
- 2 (144.10), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
- 3 following new subsection:
- 4 "On the tenth day of every month the county registrar shall
- 5 transmit to the county auditor a copy of all certificates of
- 6 death received by him during the preceding month."

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 144

The purpose of this bill is to notify the county auditor when persons die so that he can keep this records up to date. Under the present law, tax notices are often sent long after the person has died. This bill would prevent a lot of confusion in this area.

### HOUSE FILE 144

- 1 Amend House File 144 by adding the following thereto:
- 2 "On the tenth day of every month the county registrar
- 3 shall transmit to each officer in charge of permanent
- 4 voter registration in each township, city, and town within
- 5 the county having permanent voter registration, a copy of
- 6 all certificates of death received by him during the
- 7 preceding month."
