A BILL FOR

An Act relating to civil service preferred lists in cities of one hundred thousand or more population and to amend section three hundred sixty-five point eleven (365.11), Code 1958.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-five point eleven
2 (365.11), Code 1958, is amended by inserting, immediately
3 following the first paragraph thereof, the following new
4 paragraph:

5 "In cities of one hundred thousand or more population,
6 the commission shall hold in reserve a second list of the ten
7 persons next highest in standing, in order of their grade, or
8 such number as may qualify and, thereafter, if the list of
9 ten persons provided in the first paragraph hereof be exhausted
10 within one year, may certify such second list of persons to the
11 Council as eligible for appointment to fill such vacancies as
12 may exist."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 156

The requirements for qualified personnel to fill civil service positions in cities of 100,000 or more population have been demonstrated by experience to require a list of more than 10 persons within the period of one year. This bill would authorize preparation of a second list to be held in reserve for use in years in which the demand for personnel made its use necessary.
