## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the appointment of members to the state soil conservation committee.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section four hundred sixty-seven A point four  
2 (467A.4), subsection three (3), Code 1958, is hereby amended by  
3 striking all of the words after the comma in line eight (8)  
4 to the period in line twelve (12) and inserting in lieu thereof  
5 the following:  
6 "except that beginning in the year 1961, of the four committee  
7 members subject to appropriate action by the governor and senate  
8 in 1961, two (2) shall be appointed for four-year terms beginning  
9 July 1, 1961, and two (2) shall be appointed for six-year terms  
10 beginning July 1, 1961. Appointments shall be made every two  
11 (2) years and not more than two (2) members shall be appointed  
12 in any one year except to fill vacancies".
