A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the determination of eligibility and amount of assistance of aid to the blind.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred forty-one point three (241.3),
- 2 Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking all after the word "first"
- 3 in line thirteen (13) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 4 "eighty-five (85) dollars per month of earned income, plus one-
- 5 half of earned income in excess of eighty-five (85) dollars,
- 6 of such individual shall be disregarded."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 203

This amendment will make the Iowa law conform to the provisions of the federal law in regard to aid to the blind. The federal government has raised the amount to \$85 which may be disregarded in determining the amount of assistance granted, and has provided that the states will be given until July 1, 1962, to conform with the above-described provision.
