A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the boiler laws of the state of Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section eighty-nine point three (89.3),
- 2 Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding the following:
- 3 "Unfired steam pressure vessels not exceeding the
- 4 following limitations are not required to be reported to
- 5 the bureau of labor:
- 6 1. A vessel not greater than five (5) cubic feet in
- 7 volume and not having a pressure greater than two hundred
- 8 fifty (250) pounds per square inch.
- 9 2. A vessel not greater than one and one-half (1½)
- 10 cubic feet in volume with no limit on pressure."
- 1 Sec. 2. Internal inspection shall not be required on
- 2 unfired steam pressure vessels where they have been manu-
- 3 factured without inspection plate and where it would be
- 4 necessary for them to be drilled in order to be inspected
- 5 as required in section eighty-nine point two (89.2) of the
- 6 Code. The above-mentioned unfired pressure vessels must be
- 7 reported to the bureau of labor and certified by the in-
- 8 spector that in his judgment they are safe and in satis-
- 9 factory condition for the purpose for which they are used.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 300

There are some small unfired steam pressure vessels, such as sterilizers in hospitals and rollers on paper machines and others, that are almost impossible to make internal inspection except to drill and use a micrometer and this is not practical.
