A BILL FOR

An Act to define the legal right of way in traffic emerging
from slow-moving lanes.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point three
- 2 hundred six (321.306), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding
- 3 thereto the following:
- 4 Vehicles moving in a lane designated for slow-moving traffic
- 5 shall yield the right of way to vehicles moving in the same
- 6 direction in a lane not so designated when such lanes merge
- 7 to form a single lane.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 381

The purpose of this bill is to define the legal right of way where there is a slow-moving lane that merges into a single lane.
