A BILL FOR

An Act to require a special license to fish for trout, and prescribing the fee therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1),
- 2 Code 1958, is amended by inserting after line thirteen (13)
- 3 the following:
- 4 "No person, resident or nonresident, required to have a
- 5 fishing license, shall fish for trout in waters designated
- 6 by the conservation commission as 'trout waters' without
- 7 having a special license stamp affixed to his fishing license.
- 8 Special trout fishing license stamp.....\$2.00".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 446

Trout fishing pressures have increased tremendously during the last decade, and it is apparent that the trend will continue. At the present time, the costs of trout production have increased due to increased feed, labor and transportation costs. In order to maintain a high standard of trout production, both in numbers and size, to increase carrying capacities by stream improvement and acquisition, it is important that additional revenue be available. By this, trout fishermen will be contributing a more equitable share in the overall fisheries program.

This act amends section 110.1, Code 1958, to require a special trout permit in the form of a stamp to be affixed to the regular fishing license.

- 4 shall be used exclusively to restock the 'trout waters'
- 5 designated by the conservation commission."
