A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section one hundred ten point one (110.1),
Code 1958, relating to resident fishing and hunting license
fees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1),
- 2 Code 1958, is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By striking from line thirteen (13) the figures "\$2.00"
- 4 and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "\$2.50".
- 5 2. By striking from line sixteen (16) the figures "2.00"
- 6 and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "2.50".
- 7 3. By striking from line nineteen (19) the figures
- 8 "\$3.50" and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "\$4.50".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 601

No increase in license fees has been requested since 1957 and, as a consequence of spiraling operational costs, the conservation commission seeks sufficient revenue for operation of the administration and the fish and game divisions.

At the present time, the projected fiscal year balance will be less than enough to meet the expenses for one month. Longevity and other in-grade raises during the next biennium will completely exhaust the fish and game trust-fund balance and require serious cutbacks in the services rendered to the sportsmen of Iowa.
