An Act to continue and make permanent the present motor vehicle fuel taxes after July 1, 1961.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-four point three
2 (324.3), Code 1958, is amended by striking from line two (2)
3 the word "four" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "six".

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-four point seventy-
2 eight (324.78), Code 1958, is amended by striking from line
3 three (3) the word "four" and inserting in lieu thereof the
4 word "six".

1 Sec. 3. This Act shall be effective July 1, 1961, after
2 publication in The Brooklyn Chronicle, a newspaper published
3 at Brooklyn, Iowa, and in The Anamosa Eureka, a newspaper
4 published at Anamosa, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 613

This bill continues and makes permanent the special motor vehicle fuel tax levy of two cents which would otherwise expire on June 30 of this year. The tax would go into the road use tax fund.

HOUSE FILE 613

Amend House File 613 as follows:

1. By inserting the following after section 2:
"Sec. 3. Section three hundred twenty-four point sixty-three (324.63), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

(a) The net proceeds of one cent per gallon of the excise tax collected under the provisions of this chapter shall, for the period beginning July 1, 1961, and ending December 31, 1961, be credited by the treasurer of state to the primary road fund, to be used for construction of such primary roads as are presently surfaced with gravel or crushed rock only, on the basis of need as determined by the state highway commission.

(b) The net proceeds of one cent per gallon of the excise tax collected under the provisions of this chapter shall, for the period beginning July 1, 1961, and ending December 31, 1961, be credited by the treasurer of state to the primary road fund for the purpose of widening and modernization of highways and bridges."

2. Further amend House File 613 by renumbering the succeeding section.
