A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the appropriation for teachers' retirement allowance and the amount of such allowance.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred ninety-nine (199), Acts of
2 the Fifty-eighth General Assembly, is amended by striking from
3 lines seven (7), eight (8) and nine (9) of section one (1) the
4 following: ", provided, however, that the total claims paid
5 for each year of any biennium shall not exceed four hundred
6 fifty thousand (450,000) dollars".

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred ninety-four point fifteen
2 (294.15), Code 1958, is amended by striking from line twelve
3 (12) the words "not less than".

1 Sec. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 be in full force and effect from and after its publication in
3 The Sac Sun, a newspaper published at Sac City
4 Iowa, and in the Bremer County Independent, a newspaper published
5 at Waverly, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 65

This bill removes the limitation on the appropriation for the special payment of teachers' allowance provided by law. The limit will be no longer needed since the amount necessary is steadily declining.

- 1 Amend House File 65, Section 2 by adding thereto the
2 following paragraph:
3 Said section is further amended by striking from line
4 fourteen (14) the word "minimum."
