A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to members of the legislative research committee and legislative advisory committees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general
 2 fund of the state of Iowa to the following named persons the
 3 amounts set opposite their respective names in full settlement
 4 of all claims which they may have against the state of Iowa on
 5 account of services rendered as a member of the legislative
 6 research committee or a legislative advisory committee
 7 established by the legislative research committee by the
 8 authority of chapter 63, Acts of the 58th General Assembly.

2 parties shall be in full settlement of all claims against the
3 state of Iowa growing out of the above-described claims.

1 Sec. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 take effect and be in full force from and after its publication
3 in Creston News Advertiser, a newspaper published at Creston,
4 Iowa and The Sioux Center News, a newspaper
5 published at Sioux Center, Iowa.
