## A BILL FOR

An Act to transfer funds from the old-age assistance fund of the social security department to the emergency relief fund of the social welfare department.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby transferred from the appropriation  
2 to the social welfare department for the old-age assistance fund  
3 for the biennium ending June 30, 1961, as provided by section one  
4 (1) of chapter nine (9), Acts of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly,  
5 the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), to be used  
6 in the following manner:

7 For emergency relief fund.....\$20,000.00

1 Sec. 2. This Act being of immediate importance shall be in  
2 full force and effect from and after its passage and publication  
3 in The Tipton Conservative, a newspaper published in Tipton, Iowa,  
4 and the Logan Herald-Observer, a newspaper published in Logan,  
5 Iowa.

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 676
