An Act to amend section one hundred forty-nine point four (149.4), Code 1958, relating to entrance requirements for schools of chiropody.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-nine point four
- 2 (149.4), subsection two (2), Code 1958, is amended by striking
- 3 from line four (4) of said subsection the words "one year's"
- 4 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "two years".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 70

In order to better serve the public, the present trend in all professions of the healing arts is to raise the entrance requirements in the pre-professional colleges. Upon recommendation of the council on education of the American Podiatry Association, four of the six recognized chiropody (podiatry) colleges now require two years of college training as a pre-entrance requirement and the other two colleges will adopt this requirement in the near future.

This bill places the entrance requirements for chiropody colleges in line with those of other professions.
