A BILL FOR

An Act creating the general contingent fund of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1961, and ending June 30, 1963, and appropriating thereto the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) from the general fund of the state, specifying the purposes for which the appropriation may be used, and providing for a report of the dispositions made of the fund.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The general contingent fund of the state for the
2 biennium beginning July 1, 1961, and ending June 30, 1963, is
3 hereby created and said fund shall consist of the sum of one
4 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) hereby
5 appropriated thereto from the general fund of the state. Said
6 contingent fund shall be administered by the budget and
7 financial control committee and allocations therefrom may be
8 made only for contingencies other than those concerning chapter
9 nineteen point seven (19.7), Code of 1958, arising during the
10 biennium which are legally payable from the funds of the state.
11 Allocations may be made for compensation and expense of members
12 of the budget and financial control committee, authorized by
13 section two point forty-five (2.45), Code 1958, and for the
14 payment of obligations incurred under the provisions of sub-
15 section six (6) of section two point forty-four (2.44), Code 1958,
16 and for the support of the legislative research bureau. The
17 budget and financial control committee shall not allocate any
18 funds for any purpose or project which was presented to the gen-

19 eral assembly by way of a bill and which failed to become enacted
20 into law. A report of the dispositions made of the fund during
21 the first eighteen months of the biennium shall be made by the
22 budget and financial control committee to the state comptroller
23 prior to the convening of the sixtieth general assembly and by
24 him included in the printed budget. Any balance in said contin-
25 gent fund as of June 30, 1963, shall revert to the general fund
26 of the state.

27 Upon the request of the board of control, the budget and
28 financial control committee is authorized to provide from the
29 general contingent fund two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00),
30 or so much as may be necessary for the purchase of supplies which
31 may not be available through the commodity credit corporation of
32 the United States department of agriculture as provided during
33 the past biennium.

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT
ON HOUSE FILE 713

TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE:

We, the undersigned members of the conference committee appointed to consider the differences between the Senate and House on House File 713, a bill for an act creating the general contingent fund of the state beginning July 1, 1961, and ending June 30, 1963, and appropriating thereto the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from the general fund of the state, specifying the purposes for which the appropriation may be used, and providing for a report of the dispositions made of the fund, beg leave to report and make the following recommendations:

1. That the Senate recede from their amendment.
2. That House File 713 be amended as follows:
 - a. Amend section 1, lines 3 and 4, by striking "two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00)" and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "one million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,250,000.00)".
 - b. Further amend section 1 by striking in lines 29 and 30 the following: "two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00), or so much as may be necessary".
 - c. Amend the title, lines 3 and 4, by striking "two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00)" and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "one million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,250,000.00)".
