A BILL FOR

An Act to amend House File three hundred five (305), Acts of the Fifty-ninth General Assembly, now on file in the office of the secretary of state relating to funds for the manufacture of motor vehicle registration plates.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one (1) of House File three hundred five
2 (305), Acts of the Fifty-ninth General Assembly, is amended by
3 striking all of lines four (4) through eight (8) and inserting
4 in lieu thereof the following:

5 On the effective date of this Act and annually on November 1
6 of each year the treasurer of state shall transfer three hundred
7 seventy-five thousand (375,000) dollars to the division of
8 motor vehicle registration of the department of public safety
9 for the purpose of purchasing supplies and materials and for
10 the cost of manufacture of motor vehicle registration plates
11 at the prison industries. Any amount unexpended for this
12 purpose at the end of the biennial period shall be credited to
13 the road use tax fund.

1 Sec. 2. Section two (2) of House File three hundred five
2 (305), Acts of the Fifty-ninth General Assembly, is amended by
3 inserting in line ten (10) after the word "percent" the
4 following: ", less three hundred seventy-five thousand (375,000)
5 dollars,".

1 Sec. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall

- 2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
- 3 publication in The Montezuma Republican, a newspaper published
- 4 at Montezuma, Iowa, and in The Algona Upper Des Moines, a
- 5 newspaper published at Algona, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 714

This bill amends a bill passed this session which contained some erroneous assumptions that certain provisions were covered by existing statutes, when in fact they are not. This bill corrects the errors and also increases the amount of funds needed for registration plates.

HOUSE FILE 714

- 1 Amend House File 714 as follows:
- 2 1. Insert the following after the period (.) in line eleven
- 3 (11) of section one (1):
- 4 "The border and message on all such motor vehicle registration
- 5 plates, beginning with the plates of the year 1963, shall have a
- 6 reflectorized surface."
- 7 2. Strike lines five (5) through seven (7), inclusive, of
- 8 section one (1) and insert in lieu thereof the following:
- 9 "On the effective date of this Act the treasurer of state
- 10 shall transfer three hundred seventy-five thousand (375,000)
- 11 dollars and annually on November 1 of each year the treasurer of
- 12 state shall transfer four hundred twenty-five thousand (425,000)
- 13 dollars, to the division of".
- 14 3. Strike in lines four (4) and five (5) of section two (2)
- 15 the words and figures "three hundred seventy-five thousand
- 16 (375,000) dollars," and insert in lieu thereof the words "the
- 17 amount transferred during such fiscal year for motor vehicle
- 18 registration plates as provided in this section,".
