83-0 **A BILL FOR**

An Act to appropriate funds from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the conservation commission for construction, replacement, repairs, acquisition of land, development, forestry, watershed area improvements, siltation and boundary surveys, and dredging.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the state
2 conservation commission from the general fund of the state of
3 Iowa the sum of one million nine hundred ten thousand six
4 hundred dollars (\$1,910,600.00) for construction, replacement,
5 repairs, development and alterations to state parks and reserves,
6 state forests and state waters, and for dredging, artificial
7 lake development, erosion control, for stream and lake access,
8 land acquisition, and for siltation and boundary surveys.

1 Sec. 2. Said sum shall be allocated in the following amounts:

1 Sec. 3. The funds appropriated and set aside by this Act
 2 shall not be expended until it shall be determined by the
 3 conservation commission with approval of the budget and financial
 4 control committee that its expenditures shall be for the best
 5 interests of the state.

1 Sec. 4. The treasurer of the state of Iowa is hereby
 2 empowered to invest any of the funds so appropriated and set
 3 aside by the provisions of section one (1) of the Act in
 4 securities of the United States government.

1 Sec. 5. When contracts, plans and specifications for
 2 improvements for which funds are herein appropriated have been
 3 accepted by the conservation commission and approved and certified
 4 by the budget and financial control committee of the state of
 5 Iowa, the state treasurer is authorized and directed to sell
 6 sufficient securities herein provided in section four (4) of
 7 this Act to cover the cost of said improvement.

1 Sec. 6. The provisions of all Acts or statutes in conflict
 2 or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby
 3 repealed.

1 Sec. 7. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,
 2 clause or phrase of this Act is for any reason held to be
 3 unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or
 4 invalidity shall not affect the constitutionality or validity
 5 of the remaining portions of this Act. The General Assembly
 6 hereby declares that it would have passed this Act and each

7 section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
 8 hereof irrespective of whether any one or more of the sections,
 9 subsections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
 10 declared unconstitutional.

1 Sec. 8. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
 2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
 3 publication as provided by law, in The Brooklyn Chronicle, a
 4 newspaper published at Brooklyn, Iowa, and in the Algona
 5 Kossuth County Advance, a newspaper published at Algona, Iowa.
