A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the certain erroneous references to municipal Corporations having a population in excess of 2,000 as "towns".

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section four hundred eight A point one (408A.1),
- 2 Code 1958, is amended by striking from lines nineteen (19) and
- 3 twenty-three (23) the words "and towns".
- 1 Sec. 2. Section one (1) of chapter two hundred eighty-three
- 2 (283). Acts of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly, is amended by
- 3 striking from line one (1) the words "and towns".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 91

Towns are defined by statute (section 363.4) as incorporated places having a population of less than 2,000. Some references to "towns" having a population way in excess of 2,000 have erroneously been included in some statutes. This bill corrects three such references.
