A BILL FOR

An Act relating to county medical examiners.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-one point thirty-five
2 (141.35), Code 1958, is amended by striking all of the last
3 three (3) lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
4 "chapter two hundred fifty-eight (258), Acts of the Fifty-eighth
5 General Assembly."

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred forty-two point three (142.3),
2 Code 1958, is amended by striking from the third (3d) line
3 from the end of said section the word "coroners" and inserting
4 in lieu thereof the words "medical examiners".

1 Sec. 3. Section six hundred twenty-two point sixty-four
2 (622.64), Code 1958, is amended by striking from line three
3 (3) the following, "coroner,".

1 Sec. 4. Wherever in the statutes other than this Act the
2 term "coroner" is used in reference to the county officer re-
3 placed by a medical examiner by chapter two hundred fifty-
4 eight (258), Acts of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly, the
5 Code Editor is authorized to make such change in conformity
6 with the intent of said Act.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 96

Chapter 258, Acts of the 58th General Assembly, abolished the office of coroner and substituted a county medical examiner. Some references were overlooked and are changed by this bill.

HOUSE FILE 96

1 Amend House File 96 by renumbering Section four (4) thereof
2 as Section five (5) and by adding the following section:
3 Section 4. Section sixty-four point eleven (64.11),
4 Code 1958, is amended by striking from line three (3) the
5 word "coroner" and inserting in lieu thereof the words
6 "medical examiner".
