A BILL FOR

An Act relating to appeals to the state board of social welfare under aid for the blind.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred forty-one point eleven
2 (241.11), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding after
3 "representatives." in line thirteen (13) the following:
4 "Following such hearing the state board shall take its
5 final action and notify the appellant in writing.
6 "An applicant or recipient after a review hearing hereinabove
7 provided, within thirty (30) days after notice of such action is
8 given, may appeal from the decision of the state board to the
9 district court of the county in which the applicant or recipient
10 resides, by serving a ten (10) days notice of such appeal upon
11 any member of the state board, in the manner required for the
12 service of an original notice in any civil action. Upon the
13 service of such notice, the state board shall furnish the
14 applicant with a copy of the application and all supporting
15 papers, a transcript of the testimony taken in a hearing, if any,
16 and a copy of its decision. The district court shall act as an
17 appellate court to review the decision of the state board to
18 determine whether or not it has therein committed fraud or
19 abused its discretion. The costs may be taxed to appellant
20 where the appeal is affirmed or may be remitted."
