A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the safety of pupils while entering or leaving public or private school busses in cities and towns.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point three
- 2 hundred seventy-two (321.372), Code 1958, is amended by
- 3 inserting immediately following the word "districts" in line
- 4 two (2) of the last paragraph of said section the words
- 5 " , unless so provided by ordinance, ".

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 207

The purpose of this bill is to enable cities and towns to require motor vehicles to stop for school busses in business and residence districts. The amendment will make it possible for cities and towns to adopt such ordinances without infringing upon the requirement in section 321.236, Code 1958, that traffic ordinances be consistent with the provisions of chapter 321.
