A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter four hundred fifty-five (455), Code 1958,
relating to levee and drainage districts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Any levee or drainage district organized, or in
- 2 the process of being organized, under the laws of this state may
- 3 occupy and use for any lawful levee or drainage purpose land
- 4 owned by the state of Iowa, upon first obtaining permission to
- 5 do so from the state or state agency controlling the same.
- 6 In the case of lands lying within the beds of meandered streams
- 7 and border streams the permission shall be obtained from the
- 8 state conservation commission, or its successor. In the case of
- 9 lands that are under the control of no office or agency of the
- 10 state, then the permission shall be obtained from the executive
- 11 council.
- 12 Such permission shall not be unreasonably withheld and shall
- 13 be in the form of an easement executed by the governor or in the
- 14 case of an agency, by the chairman or presiding officer thereof,
- 15 and when once granted shall be perpetual, except that if no use is
- 16 made of the same for a period of five years such permission shall
- 17 immediately thereafter expire.
- 1 Sec. 2. All uses and occupancies as contemplated by this Act
- 2 existing on the effective date of this Act are hereby legalized.
