A BILL FOR

An Act relating to joint use of municipal sewers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred ninety-two point one (392.1),

2 Code 1958, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu

3 thereof:

4 "When the governing bodies of two (2) or more cities or towns

5 shall determine that it would be beneficial to the health, safety,

6 or welfare of the inhabitants of such cities or towns to make

7 joint use of all or any part of the sanitary sewer system and/or

8 sewage disposal facilities of any or all of such cities or towns,

9 or to construct a sanitary sewer system and/or sanitary sewage

10 disposal facilities to be used jointly by said cities or towns,

11 they are authorized to contract with each other for such joint

12 use, including an annual charge for the same, and to finance the

13 construction, acquisition and maintenance of said sanitary sewer

14 system and/or sewage disposal facilities by any or all of the

15 methods outlined in section three hundred ninety-two point eleven

16 (392.11), Code 1958, as amended, or by any other method legally

17 available to them under any other provision of the Code."

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred ninety-two point eleven (392.11),

2 Code 1958, is amended by striking all of said section after the

3 word "herein" in line seven (7) and inserting in lieu thereof the

4 following:

5 "and such bonds and certificates shall be payable in not more
6 than twenty (20) annual installments and at interest not
7 exceeding five (5) per cent per annum, and shall be payable in
8 such place and be in such form as the governing body shall
9 designate by resolution or ordinance. Such bonds and certificates
10 may be sold to meet the project cost in whole or in part. Project
11 construction cost may also be met by any or all of the following
12 methods:

13 1. Issuing general obligation sewer bonds authorized by
14 section three hundred ninety-six point twenty-two (396.22),
15 Code 1958, or any other applicable provision of the Code now or
16 hereafter adopted;

17 2. Issuing revenue bonds in accordance with chapter three
18 hundred ninety-four (394) of the Code;

19 3. Establishing rates or charges for the maintenance and for
20 the use of and the service rendered by the sanitary sewer system
21 and/or sewage disposal facility in accordance with the provisions
22 of chapters three hundred ninety-three (393) and three hundred
23 ninety-four (394) of the Code."

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 357

This bill permits cities and towns to make joint use of their sanitary sewer system and sewage disposal facilities.

2 "This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect
3 and be in force from and after its passage and publication in
