## A BILL FOR

An Act to prohibit the use, possession or control of X-ray machines for the purpose of shoe-fitting.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. "Whoever uses, possesses or controls, with intent
- 2 to so use, any fluoroscopic or X-ray machine for the purpose of
- 3 shoe fitting or attempting to fit shoes, or knowingly permits
- 4 such machine, whether or not in use, to remain on his premises,
- 5 shall be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred dollars
- 6 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than sixty
- 7 days or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day of such
- 8 use, possession or control shall constitute a separate
- 9 violation of this Act."
