A BILL FOR

An Act relating to planning assistance for cities, towns, counties regional and metropolitan areas.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one (1) of chapter two-hundred eighty (280),
2 Acts of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly is hereby amended as
3 follows:

4 1. By striking from lines four (4), five (5) and six (6) the
5 words "and towns that now or hereafter have a population of less
6 than twenty-five thousand (25,000) in the solution of their local
7 planning problems;" and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
8 ", towns, counties, groups of adjacent communities, incorporated
9 or unincorporated, other cities, towns and counties which have
10 suffered substantial damage as a result of a catastrophe, areas
11 where rapid urbanization has resulted or is expected to result
12 from the establishment or rapid and substantial expansion of a
13 Federal installation, and metropolitan and regional areas;"

14 2. By inserting in line six (6) after the word "reserve" the
15 following: ", contract for".

1 Sec. 2. Section two (2) of chapter two-hundred eighty (280),
2 Acts of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly is hereby amended by
3 striking from lines two (2) and three (3) the words "or town that
4 now or hereafter has a population of less than twenty-five
5 thousand (25,000)," and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
6 ", town, county, regional or metropolitan area".
