A BILL FOR

Act to make appropriations to members of the committee on highway study, namely: D. C. Nolan, Merle Hagedorn, James R. Dougherty, Gene L. Hoffman, Russell Eldred, Carroll McCurdy, Neal Pierce, Kenneth Robinson, Charles F. Iles and Miles P. Sutera.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 road use tax fund of the state of Iowa, as provided in
3 chapter three hundred twelve (§12), Code 1958, to the following
4 persons the amounts set opposite their respective names in
5 full settlement of all claims which they may have against the
6 state of Iowa on account of services rendered as a member of
7 the committee on highway study, to wit:

1 Sec. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to
2 issue his warrants to the above named parties in the amounts

3 stated, and the treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same
4 from the funds herein appropriated.

1 Sec. 3. The acceptance of said sums by the above named
2 parties shall be in full settlement of all claims against the
3 state of Iowa growing out of the above described claims.
