A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred forty-seven (147), Code 1958, relating to appointment of inspector by board of dental examiners and fixing compensation therefor, and relating to dental license renewal fees and the expenditure thereof.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. Amend chapter one hundred forty-seven (147), Code 1958, by adding the following:

3 "The board of dental examiners is authorized to employ an
4 inspector, who shall not be a member of the examining board,
5 at such per diem compensation as shall be fixed by the executive
6 council and payable from a special fund in the office of the
7 treasurer of the state known as the state board of dental
8 examiners fund."

1 Sec. 2. Further amend chapter one hundred forty-seven (147),
Code 1958, by adding the following:

"The secretary of the dental examiners shall annually add
4 four (4) dollars to the renewal fee provided in this chapter for
5 a person licensed to practice dentistry. Such additional amount
6 shall be considered as a part of the regular renewal fee and
7 payment of same by a licensee shall be a prerequisite to the
8 renewal of his license. The funds derived from the additional
9 renewal fee collected under this section shall be placed in a
10 special fund by the treasurer of the state and the state
11 comptroller to be known as the 'State Board of Dental Examiners

12 Fund', to be used by the examining board to assist in
13 administering and enforcing the laws relating to the practice
14 of dentistry, and no part of such expense shall be paid out of
15 the state treasury. Any remainder in said fund at the end of
16 each fiscal year shall be paid into the general fund of the
17 state. Said fund shall be subject at all times to the warrant
18 of the state comptroller, drawn upon written requisition of the
19 chairman of examining board and attested by the secretary, for
20 the payment of all salaries, per diem expense, and other expenses
21 necessary to administer and aid in the enforcement of the
22 provisions of law relating to the practice of dentistry, but in
23 no event shall the total expenses therefor exceed the total fees
24 collected and deposited to the credit of said fund."

4 "Said inspector shall confine his inspections to offices of
5 licensed dentists and shall not inspect or enter upon or hire
6 other persons to inspect or enter upon the premises of any dental
7 laboratory."
