## A BILL FOR

An Act permitting tuition students to attend school in districts which have an area vocational technical high school or program.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section two hundred eighty-two point seven  
2 (282.7), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding the following  
3 paragraph:  
4 "Any school district which does not have an area vocational  
5 technical high school or program, established and approved  
6 under the provisions of chapter two hundred fifty-eight (258),  
7 may permit a resident child to attend school in another dis-  
8 trict which has such a school or program. Said child shall meet  
9 the entrance requirements of the school district which has such  
10 an area school or program. Tuition, but not transportation,  
11 for such a child shall be paid by the resident district as re-  
12 quired in section two hundred eighty-two point twenty (282.20)."

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred fifty-eight point four (258.4),  
2 Code 1958, is hereby amended by inserting in line three (3) of  
3 subsection (7) after the word "classes" the words " , area  
4 vocational technical high schools and programs,".

1 Sec. 3. Section two hundred eighty-six A point three  
2 (286A.3), Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking the first  
3 paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "General school aid shall be distributed under this chapter  
5 on the basis provided in section two hundred eighty-six A  
6 point four (286A.4).".

1 Sec. 4. Section two hundred eighty-six A point four  
2 (286A.4), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding to subsec-  
3 tion three (3) the following:

4 "Multiply one (1) dollar and thirty (30) cents by the  
5 number of students for which the district pays tuition for  
6 such students to attend an area vocational technical high  
7 school or program which has been established and approved under  
8 the provisions of chapter two hundred fifty-eight (258).  
9 Multiply this product by the actual number of days that the  
10 vocational technical school was officially in session, not to  
11 exceed one hundred eighty (180) days."

1 Amend Senate File 470 by striking the quotation (") mark in  
2 line 11 of section 4, and by adding to said section the  
3 following paragraph:  
4 "For any district which has an area vocational technical  
5 high school or program established and approved under the  
6 provisions of chapter two hundred fifty-eight (258), multiply  
7 one (1) dollar and fifty (50) cents by the number of full-time  
8 day students who have graduated from high school or who are  
9 beyond twenty-one (21) years of age and are tuition students.  
10 Multiply this product by the actual number of days that the  
11 school was officially in session, not to exceed one hundred  
12 eighty (180) days. A school district, in computing the tuition  
13 to charge such a student, shall deduct the amount of general  
14 aid received for such student from the regular tuition for such  
15 student."
