A BILL FOR

An Act relating to supplemental aid to recipients of old-age assistance.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred forty-nine (249), Code
- 2 1958, as amended by chapter one hundred seventy-nine (179),
- 3 Acts of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly, is hereby amended by
- 4 adding thereto the following new section:
- 5 "The old-age assistance granted to a person under this
- 6 chapter may be supplemented by another person, association,
- 7 society, corporation, or agency of county government, other
- 8 than as specified in subsection seven (7) of section two
- 9 hundred forty-nine point six (249.6) of the Code, and such
- 10 supplemental assistance shall not be considered as income under
- 11 this chapter."

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 489

The purpose of this bill is to permit recipients of old-age assistance to receive supplemental aid from other persons, associations, societies or corporations. Under the present law, if a person is receiving old-age assistance and he receives aid from others, his old-age assistance grant is reduced. This bill would not place a greater load on the state as far as old-age assistance payments are concerned, but it will help recipients because their income can be increased.
