A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the state soil conservation committee the sum of one million one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000.00) to carry on soil conservation work in soil conservation districts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state of Iowa to the state soil conservation committee the
3 sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) for each year
4 of the biennium beginning July 1, 1961, and ending June 30, 1963,
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to carry on soil conservation
6 work in soil conservation districts organized under the soil
7 conservation districts law of the state of Iowa. The fund shall be
8 used as follows:
- 9 1. Aid to soil conservation districts for district
10 commissioners' expenses, stationery, postage and other uses as
11 they may be authorized by the state soil conservation committee;
12 five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per district. Total fifty thousand
13 dollars (\$50,000.00).
- 14 2. Personnel (technicians and clerical personnel), and their
15 necessary expenses including office rental, equipment and materials
16 to be assigned to the soil conservation districts by the state
17 soil conservation committee on a need basis; four hundred fifty
18 thousand dollars (\$450,000.00).
- 1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund

2 of the state of Iowa to the state soil conservation committee the
3 sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) for each year of the
4 biennium beginning July 1, 1961, and ending June 30, 1963, or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used and expended in
6 participation and conjunction with the federal government or any
7 of its agencies in joint operations of watershed planning and
8 development within the state of Iowa.
