A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for capital improvements for buildings and grounds under the superintendent of public buildings and grounds.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
2 fund of the state to the superintendent of public buildings and
3 grounds the sum of one hundred fifteen thousand six hundred
4 dollars (\$115,600.00) to be used in the following manner:

1 Sec 2. Said sum shall be allocated in the following
2 amounts:

CAPITOL BUILDING

4 Electrical wiring—interior wiring\$ 50,000.00
5 Weather-proof and paint windows 15,600.00
6 Replace deteriorated water pipes 50,000.00

1 Sec. 3. Before any of the funds hereinabove appropriated
2 shall be expended, it shall be determined by the superintendent
3 of public buildings and grounds, with the approval of the
4 executive council, that the expenditure shall be for the best
5 interests of the state.

1 Sec. 4. Upon the completion of any project as set forth
2 in this Act, any unobligated balance remaining may be used to
3 supplement any other project as set forth in this Act or for
4 such other repairs or projects needed, and to supplement any
5 current or prior appropriation for repairs, improvements,

6 replacements, alterations, and equipment for public buildings

7 and grounds.
