A BILL FOR

An Act making appropriations for payment of miscellaneous expense incurred or authorized by the Fifty-ninth General Assembly.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1	Sec. 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds	
2	in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the following	
3	sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, in payment	
4	of miscellaneous expenses incurred or authorized by the	
5	Fifty-ninth General Assembly:

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund
2 a sum sufficient to pay the compensation made necessary by Senate
3 Concurrent Resolution 28 for services required of officers and
4 employees of the Fifty-ninth General Assembly after final adjourn-
5 ment, and prior to the convening of the Sixtieth General Assembly,
6 including any special session called during such period.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund
2 to Wayne A. Faupel the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars
3 (\$1,250.00) for extra services to the legislative research committee,
4 in accordance with agreement with said committee.

1 Sec. 4. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to make
2 available any unexpended balance of the appropriation of eight
3 thousand five hundred dollars (\$8,500.00) made to the executive
4 council in chapter fifty-five (55), Acts of the Fifty-eighth General

5 Assembly, for legislative expenses in order that such balance
6 may be applied to the payment of legislative expenses of the
7 Fifty-ninth General Assembly.

1 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
2 shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and
3 publication in the Carroll Daily Times Herald, a newspaper
4 published in Carroll, Iowa, and in The Gladbrook Tama Northern,
5 a newspaper published in Gladbrook, Iowa.
