## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the liquor control stamps.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred twenty-three point twenty-four
- 2 (123.24), Code 1958, is hereby amended by striking from lines
- 3 seven (7), eight (8) and nine (9) the words "and a facsimile of
- 4 the signature of the chairman of the liquor control commission".

SENATE FILE 80

1 Amend Senate File 80 by adding thereto the following:  
2 Sec. 2. Section one hundred twenty-three point twenty-four  
3 (123.24), Code 1958, is hereby amended by adding thereto the  
4 following:

5 At the request of the purchaser, a special seal shall be  
6 affixed to any bottle of liquor sold for use outside of the  
7 individual's home where possession of said liquor is surrendered,  
8 or a charge made for handling it. Such special seals shall be  
9 known as "surrendered-possession seals", shall be serially  
10 numbered and may provide a space suitable for inscribing an  
11 individual's name. A charge in addition to that for the  
12 liquor shall be made for such special seals of five cents an  
13 ounce for liquor of proof higher than seventy (70) proof; four  
14 cents an ounce for liquor of proof between fifty (50) and  
15 seventy (70) proof; three cents an ounce for liquor between  
16 thirty (30) and fifty (50) proof; and two cents an ounce for  
17 liquor of less than thirty (30) proof.

18 Sec. 3. Section one hundred twenty-three point fifty  
19 (123.50), Code 1958, is amended by adding the following:

20 "In computing gross sales for the purposes of this section,  
21 the receipts from special seals for use when possession is  
22 surrendered or a charge is made for handling, dispensing or  
23 mixing liquor shall not be included. All funds received for  
24 such seals shall be distributed among all of the public school  
25 districts of Iowa in proportion to their pupils in average  
26 daily attendance as defined in subsection two (2) of section  
27 two hundred eighty-three point one (283.1) of the Code.

28 Sec. 4. Chapter one hundred twenty-three (123), Code 1958,  
29 is amended by adding thereto the following:

30 Anything to the contrary notwithstanding, no such  
31 surrendered-possession seals shall be required for beer and malt  
32 liquors as defined in chapter one hundred twenty-four (124) of  
33 the Code.

34 No liquor shall be used or kept or consumed outside of an  
35 individual's home in any place where possession is surrendered  
36 or a charge is made for handling, dispensing or mixing it  
37 unless a special surrendered-possession seal is attached to  
38 each bottle used, kept or consumed in any such place.

39 Any violation of this section shall be considered a nuisance  
40 under section one hundred twenty-three point sixty (123.60)  
41 of the Code.
