An Act to provide uniforms for sheriffs and their deputies.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. The board of supervisors of each county shall
- 2 furnish suitable uniforms for the sheriff and his deputies and
- 3 such uniforms shall at all times remain the property of the
- 4 county.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 100

Many understandable difficulties arise when a person is apprehended by an officer without uniform. It is, therefore, important that law enforcement officers always be readily identifiable as such. The public has become aware that the overwhelming majority of law officers are uniformed. This has led to the public's acceptance and respect for uniformed officers and a readiness to cooperate with them.
