A BILL FOR

An Act relating to old age pensioners' homes.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred forty-nine point nineteen
- 2 (249.19), Code 1962, is hereby repealed.
- 1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred forty-nine point twenty (249.20),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By striking lines one (1) through fifty-four (54),
- 4 inclusive, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 5 "The state board shall require,".
- 6 2. By striking from lines eighty-three (83) and eighty-
- 7 four (84) the words "which spouse meets the requirements set
- 8 out in section 249.19,".
- 9 3. By adding thereto the following new paragraph:
- 10 "The state board shall not require, as a condition to the
- 11 grant of assistance, the conveyance of any real estate owned
- 12 by the Indian tribes residing in this state. This is the sole
- 13 exception to the provisions of this section."
- 1 Sec. 3. Section two hundred forty-nine point twenty-one
- 2 (249.21), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking all after
- 3 the word "void." in line six (6) of such section.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 110

This bill provides the state with a simpler method of recovering old age pension money after the pensioner and spouse are both dead. The rights of heirs are still adequately protected.

1 Amend House File 110 by striking all after the enacting
2 clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
3 Section 1. Chapter four hundred forty-six (446),
4 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the follow-
5 ing new section:
6 "In cases where taxes have been suspended four years
7 or more upon the property of a deceased old age assistance
8 recipient and no estate was opened within ninety (90)
9 days after the death of the recipient and the surviving
10 spouse of the recipient is not occupying the property,
11 the county treasurer shall issue a public bidder tax sale
12 certificate to the county auditor."
