A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter four hundred eleven (411), Code 1962,
relating to retirement systems for policemen and firemen.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter four hundred eleven (411), Code 1962,
 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
 3 "Cities and towns shall provide hospital, nursing, and
 4 medical attention for the members of the police and fire
 5 departments of such cities, when injured while in the per-
 6 formance of their duties as members of such department, and
 7 the cost of such hospital, nursing, and medical attention
 8 shall be paid out of the appropriation for the department to
 9 which such injured person belongs; provided that any amounts
 10 received by such injured person under the workmen's compen-
 11 sation law of the state, or from any other source for such
 12 specific purposes, shall be deducted from the amount paid
 13 by such city or town under the provisions of this section."

1 Sec. 2. Chapter four hundred eleven (411), Code 1962,
 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
 3 "Firemen employed in the fire department of cities of ten
 4 thousand population or more, or under civil service, shall
 5 not be required to remain on duty for periods of time which
 6 will aggregate in each month more than an average of sixty-
 7 eight hours per week and no single period of time, or shift,

8 shall exceed twenty-four hours in length, provided that in
9 cases of serious emergencies such firemen may be required to
10 remain on duty until such emergency has passed, when so ordered
11 by the chief of the department or person acting in his place.
12 Firemen called back to duty under this provision shall be duly
13 compensated in accordance with their regular hourly wage.

1 Sec. 3. Chapter four hundred eleven (411), Code 1962,
2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 "The provisions of section two (2) shall not apply to the
4 chief, or other persons when in command of a fire department,
5 nor to firemen who are employed subject to call only."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 173

This bill adds the above sections which are contained in chapter 410 as 410.18, 410.19 and 410.20, which also applies to policemen and firemen, but will eventually run out when there are no longer any members of 410.

HOUSE FILE 173
