## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to road use tax reporting requirements in cities and towns.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twelve point eleven
- 2 (312.11), Code 1962, is amended as follows:
- 3 1. By striking in lines three (3) and four (4) the words
- 4 "or town" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "of
- 5 more than five thousand (5,000) population".
- 6 2. By striking in line seven (7) the words "city or town"
- 7 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "such city".
- 8 3. By striking in line eleven (11) the words "city or town"
- 9 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "such city".
- 10 4. By striking in line fourteen (14) the words "or town".
- 1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twelve point twelve
- 2 (312.12), Code 1962, is amended by striking the remainder of
- 3 the section after the word "proposed" in line eighteen (18)
- 4 and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "street
- 5 construction for its streets for the ensuing calendar year."
- 1 Sec. 3. Section three hundred twelve point thirteen
- 2 (312.13), Code 1962, is amended by adding thereto the following:
- 3 "However, any city or town of five thousand (5,000)
- 4 population or less shall be required to provide such information
- 5 for its entire street system only, rather than for each street

6 system."

- 1 Sec. 4. Section three hundred twelve point fourteen
- 2 (312.14), Code 1962, is amended by adding thereto the following:
- 3 "However, any city or town of five thousand (5,000)
- 4 population or less shall be required to provide such information
- 5 for its entire street system only, rather than for each street
- 6 system."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 187

This bill would eliminate the requirement, for cities and towns of less than 5,000 people, that the detailed street budgets, programs and financial reports be broken down between arterial streets and local streets. Instead it would require that such information be shown only for the entire street system. The passage of this bill would eliminate much red tape and would result in more realistic and useful reporting requirements for more than 800 small communities of Iowa.

HOUSE FILE 187

1 Amend House File 187 as follows:

2 1. By striking in section 1 the remainder of such  
3 section after the word "is" in line 2 and inserting in  
4 lieu thereof the following: "hereby repealed and the  
5 following enacted in lieu thereof:

6 'On and after January 1, 1963, each city or town shall  
7 keep accounts showing the amount spent on street construction  
8 and reconstruction on arterial streets and the amount spent  
9 on street construction and reconstruction on local streets.  
10 Such amounts proposed to be spent on arterial streets and  
11 such amounts proposed to be spent on local streets shall be  
12 shown on the street budget report required by section three  
13 hundred twelve point thirteen (312.13), Code 1962, and such  
14 amounts spent for such purposes shall be shown on the annual  
15 street report required by section three hundred twelve point  
16 fourteen (312.14), Code 1962.

17 'Of the total street construction and reconstruction  
18 expenditures made each year from road use tax funds by each  
19 city or town, at least seventy-five (75) percent shall be  
20 spent on the arterial streets of such city or town. However,  
21 if any city or town council by resolution declares that the  
22 seventy-five (75) percent is not needed on its arterial  
23 streets, then it may be used on any other streets in the city  
24 or town.'

25 2. By striking section 2 and inserting in lieu thereof  
26 the following: "Section three hundred twelve point twelve  
27 (312.12), Code 1962, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in  
28 lieu thereof:

29 'Cities which receive allotments of funds from road use  
30 tax funds which have a population of at least five thousand  
31 (5,000) shall prepare and submit annually by December 10  
32 in each year to the state highway commission for examination  
33 and review, a program of street construction and reconstruc-  
34 tion on both the arterial street system and the local street  
35 system of such city for a period of three (3) years subsequent  
36 to the year in which the program is submitted. Such cities  
37 and towns which have a population of less than five thousand  
38 (5,000) shall prepare and submit annually by December 10  
39 each year to the state highway commission for examination  
40 and review, a program of proposed street construction and  
41 reconstruction for its arterial streets and local streets  
42 for the ensuing calendar year.'

43 3. By striking in section 3 the remainder of such  
44 section after the word "amended" in line 2 and inserting  
45 in lieu thereof the following: "by striking the remainder of  
46 such section after the word 'submit' in line three and insert-  
47 ing in lieu thereof the following:

48 'by December 10 each year to the state highway commission  
49 for examination and review, a budget showing all proposed  
50 street receipts and expenditures for the city or town for the  
51 ensuing calendar year.'

52 4. By striking in section 4 the remainder of such  
53 section after the word "by" in line 2 and inserting in  
54 lieu thereof the following: "striking the remainder of  
55 such section after the word 'prepare' in line three and  
56 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

57 'and submit by March 10 each year to the state highway  
58 commission an annual report showing all street receipts  
59 and expenditures for the city or town for the previous  
60 calendar year.'
