## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the attendance at approved public high schools of children from institutions under jurisdiction of the board of control.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred eighty-two point eighteen
- 2 (282.18), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from lines
- 3 three (3) and four (4) the words "the Iowa juvenile home or
- 4 the Iowa Annie Wittenmyer home" and inserting in lieu thereof
- 5 the words "any institution under the jurisdiction of the board
- 6 of control".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 188

The majority of board of control institutions have children in residence. Some of the children should, and do, attend public schools. The existing statute provides only for payment of tuition and transportation for children residing at Davenport and Toledo.

The purpose of this proposed change is to furnish a clear legal basis for school districts to file proper claims for tuition and transportation for all children who attend school while residing in any state institution. This would involve very few children in institutions other than Davenport and Toledo, but occasionally the need arises and it is necessary to send a child to school outside the institution. This bill permits payment of the tuition and transportation.
