A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the issuance of special automobile license plates to seriously disabled veterans.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hun-

2 dred five (321.105), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding

3 the following:

4 "Seriously disabled veterans who have been provided with an

5 automobile by the United States Government under the provisions

6 of section one thousand nine hundred one ((1901), chapter thirty-

7 nine (39), title thirty-eight (38) of the United States Code,

8 shall be exempt from payment of the automobile registration fee

9 provided in this chapter, and shall be provided, without fee,

10 with a license plate.

1 Sec. 2. The disabled veteran, to be able to claim the above

2 benefit, must be a resident of the state of Iowa and must produce

3 a certificate of title to the automobile owned and registered in

4 this state in the name of said veteran."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 457

This bill would provide free auto license plates to those seriously disabled veterans who have been provided with or are eligible to receive specially equipped automobiles by the Veterans Administration under provisions of Public Law 85-857.
