A BILL FOR

An Act to permit the erection of junior college buildings and provide for equipment and to permit indebtedness and issuance of bonds therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred ninety-six point one (296.1),
- 2 Code 1962, is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
- 3 "Any such school corporation shall also be allowed to become
- 4 indebted, under the above conditions, and issue bonds therefor
- 5 to build and equip a junior college building when authorized by
- 6 section two hundred eighty point eighteen (280.18) of the Code.
- 7 Said proposition may be placed on the same ballot as provided
- 8 in said section."
