A BILL FOR

An Act to authorize examinations of the financial condition and transactions of county and memorial hospitals by certified or registered public accountants in lieu of examinations by the auditor of state.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section eleven point six (11.6), Code 1962, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following:
- 3 "Provided however that, in lieu of an examination by state
- 4 accountants the local governing body of county hospitals organized
- 5 under chapters three hundred forty-seven (347) and three hundred
- 6 forty-seven A (347A) of the Code and memorial hospitals organized
- 7 under chapter thirty-seven (37) of the Code, in case it elects
- 8 to do so, may contract with or employ, certified or registered
- 9 public accountants, certified and registered in the state of Iowa,
- 10 and pay for the same from the proper public funds; in the same
- 11 manner and under the same conditions as provided in sections
- 12 eleven point eighteen (11.18) and eleven point nineteen (11.19)
- 13 of the Code for cities and school districts."

(Committee Amendment)

- 1 1. By adding to section 1 thereof the following:
- 2 "The report of such examination of a county or memorial hospital
- 3 filed by the accountant employed with the auditor of state, as
- 4 required by section eleven point nineteen (11.19) of the Code,
- 5 shall be in the form prescribed by the auditor of state."
