## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred six (106), Code 1962, relating to registration period for motorboats to be used in Iowa waters.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section one hundred six point five (106.5),  
2 subsection seven (7), Code 1962, is hereby amended by insert-  
3 ing in line five (5) after "chapter." the following:

4 "Beginning March 1, 1963, any boats unregistered or to be  
5 renewed may be so registered and placed in the waters of the  
6 state upon receiving the registration certificate, which will  
7 have an expiration date as stated above."

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall  
2 take effect upon immediate publication and be in full force  
3 and effect from and after its passage and publication in the  
4 Newton Daily News, a newspaper published at Newton, Iowa, and  
5 in The Lyon County Reporter, a newspaper published in Rock  
6 Rapids, Iowa, all without expense to the state of Iowa.
