A BILL FOR

An Act to allow counties to provide county care for patients or inmates from mental health institutes, hospital-schools, training schools, and homes for children from the state institution fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section four hundred forty-four point twelve
- 2 (444.12), is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By striking from lines fifteen (15) and sixteen (16)
- 4 the words "Glenwood state school, the Woodward state hospital
- 5 and school" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Glenwood
- 6 state hospital-school, the Woodward state hospital-school".
- 7 2. By inserting in line twenty-one (21) after the word
- 8 "and" the words "for the support of such mentally ill or
- 9 mentally retarded persons as are cared for and supported by
- 10 the county in the county home or elsewhere outside of any
- 11 state hospital for the mentally ill or mentally retarded,".
- 12 3. By striking line twenty-seven (27) after the word "that"
- 13 through the period in line thirty-five (35) and inserting in
- 14 lieu thereof the following:
- 15 "if any patients are returned to a county from any of the
- 16 four (4) mental health institutes under the provisions of chap-
- 17 ter two hundred twenty-six point thirty-two (226.32) or from
- 18 any state hospital-school for the mentally retarded as provided
- 19 by law, the cost of care for such patients may be paid from the

20 state institution fund of the county of legal settlement in an
 21 amount commensurate with the cost of patients in the county hos-
 22 pital, county home, or other institution located in the county;
 23 if inmates of Toledo state juvenile home, Mitchellville state
 24 training school for girls, Eldora state training school for boys,
 25 and Iowa Annie Wittenmyer home are transferred or placed in
 26 foster homes in a county, the cost of care of such inmate's
 27 foster homes may be paid from the state institution fund of the
 28 county of legal settlement of such inmate in an amount not to
 29 exceed the cost per inmate in the respective state institution."
