A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate funds to defray expenses of the inaugural ceremonies.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of funds of the
 2 state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of six thousand
 3 seven hundred one dollars and ninety-six cents (\$6,701.96), or so
 4 much thereof as may be necessary, to pay the expenses incurred on
 5 account of the inaugural ceremonies and reception. Warrants
 6 shall be drawn upon the treasury for the sum herein appropriated
 7 in favor of the adjutant general upon the filing of vouchers
 8 therefor with the state comptroller.

1 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall
 2 take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and
 3 publication in The Atlantic News-Telegraph, a newspaper published
 4 at Atlantic, Iowa, and in the Mount Pleasant News, a newspaper
 5 published at Mount Pleasant, Iowa.

- 9 drawn upon the treasury for said sum in favor of Harold E. Hughes,
- 10 Governor, upon the filing of voucher therefor with the state
