A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for capital improvements for buildings and grounds under the superintendent of public buildings and grounds.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the superintendent of public buildings and grounds
3 the sum of two hundred sixty-seven thousand dollars (\$267,000.00),
4 to be used in the following manner:

1 Sec. 2. Said sum shall be allocated in the following amounts:

- 2 PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS
- 3 Capitol building exterior repairs and
- 4 maintenance work\$198,000.00
- 5 General tuckpointing cleaning
- 6 and waterproofing of masonry.....\$90,000.00
- 7 Repair stonework in unsafe
- 8 deteriorated areas 50,000.00
- 9 General metal roof gutter,
- 10 downspout and flashing repairs..... 25,000.00
- 11 Repainting exterior woodwork
- 12 as required after cleaning of
- 13 masonry 15,000.00
- 14 Contingencies for employing
- 15 construction inspector and
- 16 nominal allowance for unan-

1 Sec. 3. Before any of the funds hereinabove appropriated shall
2 be expended, it shall be determined by the superintendent of
3 public buildings and grounds, with the approval of the budget and
4 financial control committee, that the expenditure shall be for the
5 best interests of the state.

1 Sec. 4. Upon the completion of any project as set forth in
2 this Act, any unobligated balance remaining may be used to supple-
3 ment any other project as set forth in this Act. Any unencumbered
4 balance remaining as of June 30, 1967, of the appropriation of
5 this Act made by the Sixtieth General Assembly, shall revert to
6 the general fund of the state.

1 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and pub-
3 lication as provided by law in *The Winterset Madisonian*, a
4 newspaper published at Winterset, Iowa, and in *The Sheffield*
5 *Press*, a newspaper published at Sheffield, Iowa.
