# A BILL FOR

An Act making appropriations for payment of miscellaneous expense incurred or authorized by the Sixtieth General Assembly.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds
- 2 in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the following
- 3 sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, in payment of
- 4 miscellaneous expenses incurred or authorized by the Sixtieth
- 5 General Assembly:

- 9 Executive Council, telephone installation and

1    Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2    fund a sum sufficient to pay the compensation made necessary  
3    by Senate Concurrent Resolution 27 for services required of  
4    officers and employees of the Sixtieth General Assembly after  
5    final adjournment, and prior to the convening of the Sixty-

6 first General Assembly, including any special session called  
7 during such period.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2 fund to the executive council an amount sufficient to cover the  
3 cost of replacing the carpet in Senate Room 24 and 24A and the  
4 floor covering in the Lieutenant Governor's washroom.

1 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2 fund to Wayne A. Faupel the sum of six hundred and twenty-five  
3 dollars (\$625.00), for each year of the biennium, for extra  
4 services.

1 Sec. 5. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to  
2 make available any unexpended balance of the appropriation of  
3 eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$8,500.00) made to the  
4 executive council in chapter fifty, Acts of the Fifty-ninth  
5 General Assembly, for legislative expenses in order that such  
6 balance may be applied to the payment of legislative expenses  
7 of the Sixtieth General Assembly.

1 Sec. 6. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
2 shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage  
3 and publication in the New Hampton Tribune, a newspaper  
4 published in New Hampton, Iowa, and in The Atlantic News-  
5 Telegraph, a newspaper published in Atlantic, Iowa.
