A BILL FOR

An Act to establish requirements for installation of bulk tanks
on farms for milk produced for manufacturing purposes.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Any producer using a bulk tank for cooling and
2 storage of milk to be used for manufacturing purposes shall have
3 an enclosed milk room which shall conform to the standards
4 provided by this Act. The floor shall be constructed of concrete
5 or other impervious material, maintained in good repair, and
6 graded to provide proper drainage. The walls and ceilings of
7 the room shall be sealed and constructed of smooth easily cleaned
8 material. All windows shall be screened and doors shall be self-
9 closing. It shall be well ventilated and must meet the following
10 requirements:

11 1. The bulk tank shall not be located over a drain or under
12 a ventilator.

13 2. The hose port shall be located in an exterior wall and
14 fitted with a tight self-closing door.

15 3. A two hundred twenty (220) volt lock type electrical
16 connection with ground and weatherproof type receptacle and
17 switchbox shall be provided near the hose port.

18 4. Each milk room shall have an adequate supply of water
19 readily accessible with facilities for heating the water, to
20 insure the cleaning and sanitizing of the bulk tank, utensils and

21 equipment and the keeping of the milk room clean.

22 5. No lights shall be placed directly over the bulk tank.

23 6. The bulk tank shall be properly located in the milk room
24 for easy access to all areas for cleaning and servicing.

25 7. This Act shall become effective July 4, 1963, for all
26 subsequent installations of bulk tanks for milk produced for
27 manufacturing purposes.

28 8. On and after July 1, 1965, all bulk tank installations
29 existing prior to July 4, 1963, must comply with the provisions
30 of this Act.

31 9. The enforcement of this Act shall be administered by the
32 Iowa department of agriculture.

33 10. Any person violating any provision of this Act shall be
34 punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00).
